

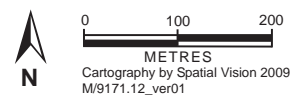
Exclusive use - The waters of Anglesea River between the bridge at the Great Ocean Road and the bridge at Coalmine Road are set aside for the exclusive use of vessels with an engine used for propulsion or manually propelled vessels subject to the 5 knot speed restriction.

Sailing vessels of more than 3 metres in length are prohibited on the Anglesea River between the entrance and the bridge at the Great Ocean Road

**State Rules:** Unless otherwise specified in a Schedule, a person must not operate a vessel on any inland waters at a speed exceeding 5 knots - (a) within 50 metres of the waters edge; or (b) within 50 metres of a fixed or floating structure in or on the water - except in an access lane.
